**Footnotes**

DAYTIME stalked the pace two deep, took over approaching the three eighths pole, was quickly clear from that point, widened on the final turn then just lasted in an all out drive. SALADIN, unhurried well back and outside, advanced through the final turn three wide, was gaining quickly and just missed. BETTER SHOP AROUND, unhurried toward mid track, saved some ground through the final turn and finished evenly. BANDINI ACE settled off the pace inside, bid from the five sixteenths pole but weakened in the stretch. BLACKBERRY WINTER settled close to the early pace inside, dropped back leaving the first turn and had no further response on the final turn. WICKED CLEVER, DUST DEVIL, SNEAKING SUSPICION and BATON were all outrun. WISHNDONTMAKEITSO had a short lead inside entering the opening turn, relinquished control near the three eighths pole and gave way readily.
