Footnotes

JADE PRINCE quickly took over to rate the pace inside, was pressured from the five sixteenths pole and mostly hand ridden through the lane. WHY SHIRLEY WHY stalked the pace off the rail, gave chase from the five sixteenths pole and proved second best while not a match for the winner. FUNNY BOOK, well back outside, bid widest leaving the five sixteenths pole, entered the stretch about the four path, angled in toward the sixteenth pole and dueled for show. STEADY EDDIE rated off the pace and off the rail, bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole, entered the stretch about the four path and leveled off from there. CAPE GIRARDEAU rated just off the early pace about the three path, started a bid past the nine sixteenths pole but leveled off from the three eighths. WOTAN, off the pace outside, made a mild bid past the half mile pole then flattened stride on the final turn. SIX CLICKS was kept in range toward mid track to the half mile pole, faded through the backstretch and not encouraged further down the lane. I GOT'M saved ground while dropping well back, eased in the stretch, was pulled up before the wire and walked off.
