Footnotes

AROUND THE TOWN eased three wide into the first turn, stalked the pace to the half mile pole, closed to contention at the three eighths, dueled to the front into the final turn, raced clear entering the stretch, lugged toward the rail a sixteenth away but held well with steady handling. WILD MAMBO, unhurried inside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, eased three wide rounding the final turn, got up for place in late yards and finished well. JOT EM DOWN rated a slim lead inside, came under pressure leaving the three eighths pole, was caught just past the quarter, continued a close factor through the turn, altered course midstretch then leveled off. TURKEY RUN settled off the pace inside then lacked significant response from the three eighths pole. NINJA NEKIA raced well back toward the outside and had no rally. BISSIX HILL, with the early pace two deep, dropped back leaving the first turn, was prompted to keep up down the backstretch then faded rounding the final turn. MICKEY MAC'S TURN was not a factor. NOTHING BUT FIRE rated off the pace inside, gave chase into the backstretch then weakened on the final turn.
