Footnotes

LOPSTER broke sharp from the outside to gain a clear early margin, widen the advantage entering the turn, and was well clear late under steady urging. MR. BLU BOY chased the early pace from the inside, made a bid entering the drive but could not reach the winner. INTHENICKOFTIMETOO stalked the early pace from the inside, responded entering the drive and finished well along the rail. DRAW THE TAP went evenly. IRISH TRINITY chased the early pace from the outside but was no threat late. NATIVE SOLEIL forced the pace from the outside and tired. HOOCH'S CAPOTE was no factor. BLINKING RED was no threat. RUSHISRIGHT was always outrun.
