Footnotes

PHIL'S PROSPECT gained a clear lead around the second turn, widened through the last turn then prevailed through the stretch while kept to urging. ROY L. stalked the leaders four wide, angled to the inside on the turn and was easily second best. COWBOY GETS EVEN settled off the pace five wide, lacked a late response. VIVO exchanged bumps after the start with LIVELY REPARATIONS, found his best stride late while five wide. OUT TO PLEASE set the early pace, remained a factor until the last turn, had little left for the drive. LIVELY REPARATIONS exchanged bumps with VIVO after the start, saved ground but had no rally. SHAMSS off a step slow, rushed to contention, tired. NUMERATE stopped after three quarters, three wide.
