**Footnotes**

SEA OF LIQUIDITY stalked the pace from the rail, tipped three wide to advance around the far turn, swept to command near the sixteenth pole and drove clear. FORCE OF GRAVITY set a clear pace near the rail, was collared near the sixteenth pole and held on for the place. RUTLEDGE STAR was four wide around the first turn, advanced inside of horses down the backstretch, raced two wide around the far turn, angled out in upper stretch and was along for the show. YELLATTHEMINISTER stalked the pace inside and lacked a rally. FURRFIELD CAT tracked the pace three wide throughout and lacked the needed rally. I GOT'M lacked speed along the rail and passed tiring rivals. PANTASTIC failed to menace while racing two wide early and four wide around the far turn. LAST TRIBUTE saved ground and never factored. CLOVER CREST chased the pace three wide and faltered around the far turn.. PIR AT THE MOON raced three and four wide, stopped and was eased.
