Footnotes

GREENWAY COURT stalked the pace two deep, challenged for control past the three eighths pole, dueled to the front a pole later, contested a slight advantage through the final turn, drew clear nearing the eighth pole and turned back the runner-up through the lane. GOLDEN SET, four wide the opening turn, settled close leaving the half mile pole, started a bid at the five sixteenths, matched strides with the winner rounding the final turn but dropped back into the stretch and finished evenly to be second best. DON'TMESSWITHALLEN steadied at the rail into the first turn, gave chase leaving the half mile pole, came between horses into the stretch but leveled off after acquiring the show position. BIG BAD IKE moved to the outside while dropping well back early, bid saving some ground toward the quarter pole and passed tiring rivals down the lane. MASTIC VILLAGE, shuffled from between horses early, gave chase from the outside leaving the nine sixteenths pole, saved ground on the final turn but had nothing left in the stretch. CASTLE CLOWN rated a short lead inside, was pressured past the three eighths pole, caught at the five sixteenths then faded on the final turn. CHIEF MCGEE, close to the early pace three wide, faded after a half mile.
