RUTLEDGE PRINCE outrun early, steadily advanced inside, reached a striking position entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive, dueled through the stretch and was just in time. BRAVO ZULU broke clean from the outside, gained a clear advantage up the backstretch, held a clear margin entering the second turn, dueled with the winner through the drive but was outfinished. TUP TAKE' PLEASE pressed the early pace from between foes, crept closer entering the second turn, but had nothing left for the drive. PERFECT WAY chased the early pace outside and tired. TUFTON chased the early pace outside, crept closer up the backstretch then faded. VALID VELVET was no factor. NOT MY PROBLEM was finished early.
