DAVID'S ROCKET chased the pace off the rail, eased out through the upper stretch and dug in determinedly to take the nod the final strides. MORE FOR YOUR BUCK rated a short lead inside, was headed midway on the turn, dug in from that point to turn back the efforts of Stormin Lex, drew clear into the lane but lost the nod through the final strides. COKER SPRING, jostled at the start, gave chase off the rail and finished evenly for show. STORMIN LEX broke awkwardly making contact with Coker Spring, engaged in close chase from the three path, challenged the pacesetter midway on the turn but was turned back entering the stretch and leveled off from there. GIN MAKES YA SIN chased the leaders toward mid track though never factored. STERILIZE exchanged contact with Coker Spring leaving the gate then gave chase off the rail. GEORGIE PORGY was no factor racing wide. WHY NOT ME lacked speed inside.
