Footnotes

BUBBA BEAR broke inward, settled back off the rail, commenced his run in the three path leaving the five sixteenths pole, circled into the stretch, switched to his correct lead a sixteenth out and surged ahead of FLAT BROWN in the final yards. FLAT BROWN was sent wide to clear, angled in to set the pace under some urging, widened past the quarter pole, continued well in front into the lane, continued on gamely but could not withstand the winner's charge. COMEONSATURDAY vied inside FLAT BROWN entering the first turn, eased back off that one and angled out to chase the pace, edged closer the far turn then kept on with interest. SIGNAL FLAG saved ground and lacked a bid. EBONY settled back inside, angled out mid way on the final turn and finished with interest. SEA REP RUN , four wide into the first turn, angled in while well back, shifted back out into the stretch but could not factor. SENOR ALLEY CAT , fractious in the gate, broke in a tangle, recovered to rush up between rivals nearing the first turn, made a slight gain off the rail nearing the far turn, failed to sustain and weakened nearing the stretch. ROCKY TWIST chased briefly two wide and dropped back.
