Footnotes

ROBB'S WARRIOR was sent up outside to take command entering the first turn, set the pace removed from the inside, took some pressure from WHY NOT JOHN down the backstretch, shook clear nearing the far turn, drifted out entering the lane, was corrected with the right stick, drifted out again near the sixteenth marker but stayed on well to prove clearly best. WHY NOT JOHN appeared to bump with SCOTTSMEN nearing the first turn which in turn forced him out a bit and to be steadied off the heels of the winner soon after, moved up three wide near the half mile marker to prompt the pace, came under pressure leaving the three sixteenths marker and chased the winner home in willing fashion. BIG BAD IKE saved ground, gradually gained leaving the quarter pole, chased the top pair into and through the stretch but came up empty late. HE'S A PRIZE , in a bit close nearing the clubhouse turn, was taken five wide into the backstretch, gained ground leaving the five sixteenths marker, continued well wide into the stretch and finished with interest. SOUTHERN SAIL , unhurried early, raced three wide between rivals leaving the far turn, continued between foes to upper stretch but never fired. BRING ONTHE CHROME lost ground four wide, raced between horses from the far turn to upper stretch then faded. SCOTTSMEN , unruly in the gate, came out some and bumped with WHY NOT JOHN nearing the first turn, saved ground stalking the early pace and weakened. An objection by the rider of WHY NOT JOHN against the winner for alleged interference entering the clubhouse turn was not allowed
