Footnotes

UNUSUAL LAZ rated back toward the inside, eased out while improving through the turn, started his bid into the stretch, took over at the sixteenth pole, edged clear from there and held well. RACE TO THE TOP gave chase toward mid track, saved ground approaching the turn, was carried to the six path into the lane then outfinished the final sixteenth. GUNNER LOUIE lacked early speed outside, rounded the turn seven wide, steadily improved outside through the stretch and finished strong. PETIONVILLE'SDREAM chased the pace from the outside, came through the turn in the seven path then leveled off in late yards. CAFE KOMODO chased the pace from the three path down the backstretch, saved some ground through the turn, had aim entering the stretch but flattened out from the sixteenth pole. LAW'S HILL steadied leaving the seven sixteenths pole, gave chase from the three eighths, was carried to the five path through the turn then leveled off down the lane. DYLAN THE DEPUTY lacked speed outside. AM SO HAPPY chased the pace from the inside, steadied near the rail midway on the turn then weakened through the stretch. BAHAMA GOLD was hustled clear past the seven sixteenths pole to set the pace off the rail, showed the way to the top of the stretch, lost ground leaving the turn, showed no response, was eased and appeared sore upon return. NIGHT TROOPER came away slowly and was not a factor.
