Footnotes

FANCY FEATHERS settled close to the early pace off the rail, raced hemmed in at the half mile pole, came between horses with a bid from the seven sixteenths to take the lead nearing the three eighths, was urged into the final turn and steadily handled to midstretch before coasting home, much the best. PROVERBIAL rated close off the rail, dueled to a slim brief lead three wide while between horses past the seven sixteenths pole, gave close chase from the three eighths to the middle of the final turn, dropped back from there and had to settle for second best. KIND HEARTED WOMAN rated off the early pace toward mid track, moved to even terms five wide near the seven sixteenths pole, gave chase from that point but dropped back nearing the final turn and finished evenly. MR. MAC'S COLLEEN stalked the pace off the rail, took a slim brief lead between horses past the half mile pole, continued in close chase down the backstretch but dropped back while leveling off on the final turn. UNUSUAL MERIT was bumped leaving the first turn, raced well back saving ground, made a mild bid from the five sixteenths pole. DOOLIN POINT saved ground while off the pace. ROYAL CIRCUS bumped Unusual Merit in the three path leaving the first turn, rated back off the rail, started a bid from the half mile pole but leveled out down the backstretch. CHIA CAT raced four and five wide on the turns and was not a factor. DRINK AND DIAL, off the pace about the four path, gave chase leaving the half mile pole then weakened nearing the final turn. FINE CASHMERE rated a slim lead inside to just past the half mile pole before fading.
