Footnotes

ELDER JOHN was rated off of TETON CLASSIC and angled out under the wire the first time, prompted that one two to three wide, moved to challenge after around the far turn, dueled from the quarter pole, gained command a sixteenth out, momentarily edged clear then dug in under stern pressure to turn back BEAR'S DELITE. BEAR'S DELITE, well placed inside stalking the pace, worked outward for room entering the lane and closed gamely. TETON CLASSIC moved clear leaving the three quarter pole and angled in, set a somewhat slow pace towards the inside, was put to a strong drive when collared a quarter mile out, dueled to the sixteenth marker and gave way grudgingly. STERLINGS G I RON lost ground four to five wide, steadily advanced from the three eighths pole to the eighth pole then flattened out. CAL CORREDOR hopped at the break to be away slowly, was rated off heels when a bit eager the opening furlong, angled out and chased between rivals nearing the far turn, remained in contention to the furlong marker then tired. ASHTON'S HUMOR had his heels clipped passing the wire the first time, raced three wide between rivals the first turn, chased for a half mile and gave way. A. P. CONQUISTADOR clipped heels and stumbled leaving the three quarter pole then dropped back.
