**Footnotes**

SAINT ZITA dropped well back of the early pace inside, improved off the rail leaving the first turn, eased to the outside with a bid approaching the quarter pole, rounded the final turn six wide, was driven to the lead inside the sixteenth pole and hand ridden to the wire. ROCKING LADY settled close about the three path, gave chase nearing the five sixteenths pole and finished well in place. SECRET LIFE OF BEA moved to a short lead nearing the nine sixteenths pole, rated the pace through most of the backstretch, responded to the challenge of Centripetal Motion from the five sixteenths, dueled clear into the lane but leveled off in late yards. CENTRIPETAL MOTION, four wide into the opening turn, rated off the early pace, bid leaving the half mile pole, contested at near even terms rounding the final turn but leveled off in the stretch. OMARA DEVIL, well back off the rail, moved toward mid track leaving the first turn, had aim three wide on the final turn but leveled off the last sixteenth. CATTAIL RUN rated close to the early pace inside, gave chase through the backstretch, took aim at the top of the stretch then leveled off the final sixteenth. RUGGED CROSS, well back off the rail, made a mild bid leaving the half mile pole, rounded the final turn four wide then weakened in the stretch. DOMINIX gave chase from off the rail and had no further response while three wide on the final turn. JUST CALL'ER had a slim lead inside the opening quarter, dropped back through the first turn then faded rounding the final turn. DOWNSTREAM BULL, awkward at the break, was no factor outside.
