RUSSELL ROAD settled off the pace in the four path, began to gain outside down the backstretch, quickly narrowed the gap while still racing in the four path rounding the far turn, continued on his left lead in the lane, steadily gained under a drive in the stretch, was up inside the sixteenth pole and pulled clear late. LUCY'S BOB BOY stalked the pace three wide around the first two turns, quickly drew abreast of the pacesetter near the half-mile pole, vied outside of that foe down most of the backstretch, took the lead near the five-sixteenths marker, drew clear leaving the quarter pole, led past the sixteenth pole but could not resist the winner late. LIVELY REPARATIONS was unhurried in the two path early, raced three wide around the far turn and rallied for the show. FRED HIGH saved ground throughout and rallied belatedly. SON OF A BEAR stalked the pace two wide and faded around the far turn. PLANTATION set the pace along the rail, vied inside down the backstretch and tired around the far turn.
