Footnotes

BUFFY BABE set the pace on the rail, drew off under a steady drive. ARISEN ANGEL bore in at the start, bothered rivals, pressed the pace three wide, had no late bid. GOLDEN NINER prompted the pace just off the rail, lacked a closing bid. ROBBIN'S APPLE saved ground, rallied three wide around the turn but only made a mild gain through the stretch. CROWNING WAVES forced the pace three wide, lacked the needed rally. COCO'S WORLD saved ground to no avail. SMOOTH TURN off a step slow and in then put tight at the start, passed tiring rivals. IRISH SHANNON bumped and steadied at the start, never threatened. SPRING POWER soundly bumped and forced back at the start, rushed up to contention but tired. TIME IN SPACE was no factor, six wide. The rider of SMOOTH TURN claimed foul against the winner alleging interference at the start. The Stewards reviewed the video tape replays and disqualified ARISEN ANGEL from second and placed her ninth.
