PEACEFUL BLISS broke alertly to set the pace on the rail, rated well down the backstretch, held a clear lead into the stretch then prevailed under steady urging. RUSSELL ROAD bumped after the start, pressed the pace tracking the winner while just off the rail, could not gain on that one while all out to hold second. COLONEL J W steadied into the first turn down along the rail, prompted the pace from, was in position on the turn and finished well through the lane. SEA RESCUE moved up three and four wide but lacked a closing bid. I GOT'M bumped at the start, stalked the leaders four wide, angled to the rail on the turn, lacked a late bid. GREEN SPRING BOY bore in at the start and bumped with I GOT'M, forced the pace three wide, lacked the needed late rally. VIVO failed to menace along the inside. GHOSTLY THUNDER well positioned on the rail, eased out four wide around the turn, never threatened in the drive. SILVER TIE AFFAIR was no factor from the inside.
