Footnotes

FREE HUMOR was bumped just after the start, stalked the pace inside, went through a narrow opening into the clubhouse turn to vie inside of ACT OF DOMINANCE around the second turn, took command near the half-mile pole, drew clear near the quarter pole and held clear under a drive. CHRISTMAS HOLLADAY bumped with the winner just after the start, was unhurried while saving ground around the first two turns, advanced outside down the backstretch, chased the winner from the three path around the far turn, could not gain in the stretch while clearly second best. REAL QUIET TIME lacked speed while racing four wide around the first turn, saved some ground around the clubhouse turn, advanced two wide around the far turn and was along for the show. TROOPER D prompted the pace three wide around the first turn, settled back to stalk the pace from the rail around the second turn, continued to save ground around the far turn but lacked a closing bid. KID KEARNY GABE failed to menace while racing three wide. ACT OF DOMINANCE set the pace in the two path and tired after six furlongs. KEY MINISTER never factored while racing two wide. TOUCHER was extremely slow into stride, lagged far back and finished well. BIG PRIZE had brief four wide speed. CAROLINA BARON disputed the early pace between rivals and faltered down the backstretch.
