ALLY BEAR chased the pace inside through the backstretch, raced boxed in rounding the turn, slipped through an opening at the rail entering the stretch, took over past the eighth pole and just lasted in an all out drive. SHINE FOR ME hesitated a full length leaving the gate, steadily made up ground off the rail, eased six wide leaving the turn, lugged in under a hard right handed whip, brushed The Urugaucha in deep stretch and just missed the win. THE URUGAUCHA stayed with the pace three wide while between horses, raced gamely throughout but was brushed and steadied in deep stretch. FRENCH FITZ chased the pace from the outside down the backstretch, saved some ground on the turn then eased out through the lane while finishing well. AMERICAN APPEAL raced with the four wide through the backstretch, continued a close factor rounding the turn, entered the stretch six wide but leveled off late. GOOD LOOKING GIRL gave close chase outside down the backstretch, was strung seven wide leaving the turn then leveled off down the lane. BROOKS LASS gave chase toward mid track, rounded the turn six wide, was blocked into the lane and leveled off from there. ZALADY raced with the pace off the rail, contested a close presence through the turn, came out a path entering the stretch then faded. WILD AND GOTAWAY chased the pace off the rail down the backstretch, eased toward the outside nearing the turn, entered the stretch widest, showed little more, was unsaddled on the turn, appeared to

be sore but walked off. BUSY SISTER raced a part of the pace inside, contested a slim advantage at the rail rounding the turn, lost some ground entering the stretch, was caught at that point and weakened. The stewards posted the inquiry to review the incident in late stretch but made no change.
