GATOR DONE hustled clear for inside position to rate the pace, came under pressure leaving the quarter pole and was steadily encouraged to last. COUNTRY HELLO settled back about the two path, started a bid nearing the quarter pole, improved at the rail rounding the final turn, drew close in deep stretch and finished evenly. LAST OF HIS KIND, well back inside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, angled five wide entering the stretch then leveled off late. PREPPIES LIL MAN rated close off the rail, gave chase from the seven sixteenths pole but lost ground leaving the final turn and weakened in the stretch. BY A LANDSLIDE, just off the pace inside, gave chase from the three eighths pole, eased to the three path rounding the final turn then leveled off down the lane. WOODYS A GOODIE, well back off the rail, angled to the outside leaving the final turn and passed tiring rivals. MR. ETHAN, five wide the opening turn, settled off the pace toward mid track then faded after a half mile. FOREVER BLESSING was kept close toward the outside to the three eighths pole and faded from there. FLIP'S FOLLY was no factor outside early then saved ground on the final turn. TSENGELIIN MANLAI kept close to the early pace toward mid track then stopped nearing the five sixteenths pole.
