BIG DIAMOND gained a clear lead down the backstretch, drew off around the turn, prevailed while kept to urging. QUICK AFFAIR advanced three and four wide and was second best late. QUE BULL set the early pace, remained a factor until the turn, lacked a closing bid. JULIA'S GRACE off a step slow, moved up three wide, dropped to the rail on the turn, never threatened in the drive. CAPTURE THE BUZZ found her best stride late, four wide. BELLA BE GOOD saved ground but had no rally. ROSES FIESTA was used up after a half, three wide. MYSTERY LUV flashed brief foot on the rail. ROLLIICKING RUBY prompted the pace three wide, tired. JALO MY HALO trailed on the rail.
