Footnotes

DAWN'S DAY in tight soon after the start, moved up three wide, rallied around the turn to become a strong factor then was up in the final strides. BLUFF THE WEATHER advanced along the rail, made a clear lead on the turn, led until the final strides. BROTHER BRYANT ranged up four wide, lacked a closing bid. HIGHNTHESKYMERCURY pressed the pace three wide, dropped to the rail on the turn, faded through the stretch. POLISH LOGIC within striking distance three and four wide, failed to respond. STRIKETHREEYOUROUT never threatened, three wide. LOGANS LIL DEVIL was used up after a half along the inside. BURR HILL BOY had little left after a half, four and five wide. WHO DEAR set the pace just off the rail, stopped after a half.
