Footnotes

GRIZZLY BAY quickly moved to the front to set a well restrained pace inside, was pressured past the three eighths pole, driven into the quarter, lost some ground leaving the final turn but dug in to widen the last sixteenth. SECOND JON stalked the pace off the rail, gave chase leaving the seven sixteenths pole and had aim to midstretch before leveling off. TUMULTUOUS rated just off the early pace about the three path, gave chase from the seven sixteenths pole, faded on the final turn and had nothing left in the stretch. TAKELA SHAM settled back from the early pace outside and showed little response through the backstretch. CHANNELOFDREAMS, well back off the rail, made only a mild bid about the three path of the final turn. P K'S SMILE, off the pace and off the rail, had no response on the backstretch. WHAT A HEMI raced well back saving ground. MOUNTAINEER MANIAC saved ground the opening turn then faded through the backstretch. MICRO BOY, jostled at the break, lost ground into the first turn then never factored.
