**Footnotes**

CAN'TSTOPATRIN contested the early lead off the rail, settled on the front end from the five eighths pole, came under pressure nearing the final turn then widened with steady stretch encouragement. JUST SAFE rated off the pace off the rail, bid leaving the three eighths pole then dueled for place through the upper stretch. FIRST BLUSH raced well off the early pace saving ground, bid in mid track from the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn about the three path and was along late for show. REDSKINSANDCOWBOYS stalked the pace about the three path, picked up the chase approaching the five sixteenths pole then leveled off rounding the final turn. GALLANT PERFORMER saved ground off the pace, gave chase leaving the seven sixteenths pole then leveled off nearest the rail on the final turn. BAYPASS rated close to the early pace toward mid track, bid saving ground nearing the five sixteenths pole then leveled off in the three path of the final turn. TIANA saved ground racing well off the pace. DOITFORBOB dropped well back and saved ground. PEACE ON EARTH was through early. YELLOWSTONE LAKE was not a factor.
