Footnotes

GINGER KID rated a slim early lead inside, drew clear at the quarter pole and opened up under steady handling. BRASSY STAR settled well back toward the outside leaving the opening turn, started a bid from the half mile pole, steadily improved about the five path of the final turn then lugged in and leveled off after obtaining place position. SASSY CHEROKEE rated just off the pace off the rail, picked up the chase from the seven sixteenths pole, was outfinished in a stretch long duel for place but held on for show. SAFFRON WONDER settled back saving some ground, bid angling outward approaching the final turn, rounded the turn about the five path and passed tiring rivals. C M'S QUIETANN saved ground racing well off the pace. CURVE APPEAL, off the pace toward mid track, showed no response through the backstretch. GOBLINS ANNAJIG raced off the pace and off the rail though showed no response through the backstretch. MONIQUE'S SONG raced with the early pace two deep, dropped back past the five sixteenths pole and faded nearest the rail leaving the final turn. CASH OUT ROBIN was through early.
