I LOVE THE ORGAN bumped at the start, set the pace inside, drew off on the turn, held clear through the stretch under a drive. SISTY ANNE pressed the pace three wide and while no match for the winner was second best. TALKIN MONEY stalked the pace three wide, failed to respond. LOVE FOR LUCY saved ground, had no rally. EXCELLENT IDEA off a step slow then bumped, hit the rail into the last turn, lacked a late bid. DIAMONDS ONLY found her best stride late, inside. COZY GLOW never was a factor four wide. WARISON exchanged bumps at the start, showed little. A NEWLOVE was used up after a half three wide. WAGE A PENNY exchanged bumps with WARISON at the start then had little impact.
