Footnotes

SCOTTY BOBBY was hustled to a slim lead nearing the three eighths pole, dug in to the challenge of Banc d'Or from the five sixteenths, turned that one back under a steady drive and held on well. DOTHAHDANCEUDO chased the early pace from mid track, had aim four wide nearing the top of the stretch and dug in from there to duel for place. BANC D'OR gave close early chase three wide, dueled two deep past the five sixteenths pole then outfinished for the top two spots while finishing well. ARCH ADVENTURE chased the early pace inside, was shuffled back from the rail at the five sixteenths pole, eased three wide rounding the turn and finished well in spite of his earlier loss of momentum. NIFTY SHOOTER chased the pace toward the outside, saved some ground on the turn and finished evenly. BEE A WINNER gave chase from the outside then leveled off in the five path of the turn. DEVIL SOUP engaged in close early chase about the three path before fading on the turn. FIRST FEAR was not a factor.
