Footnotes

NOT TOO TACKY settled off the pace along the inside, angled three wide to advance between foes around the far turn, took the lead nearing the lane, quickly drew clear and drifted in under right-handed urging. SILENT SHOT settled off the pace while racing two and three wide, advanced four wide around the far turn and finished willingly to gain the place. MY FIRST SIP lacked speed while racing three and four wide early, advanced five wide into the far turn, angled to the rail leaving the three-sixteenths pole and was just up for the show. WILD CAPTAIN BOB was caught five wide around the first turn, angled to the rail the first time through the stretch, took the lead near the half-mile pole, vied inside of KINGPOST from there to upper stretch and weakened through the lane. KINGPOST stalked the pace two wide, steadied nearing the wire the first time, reached even terms near the half-mile pole, vied two wide down the backstretch, vied between foes around the far turn and weakened in the lane. ENABLE was not a factor while racing three and four wide. PETECAROL was caught five wide around the first turn, rushed up to take the lead crossing the wire the first turn, set the pace two wide around the clubhouse turn and faded down the backstretch. SIX CLICKS went four wide around the first turn, saved ground thereafter and tired around the far turn. BIG CAL set the pace off the rail and was done early. The rider of SILENT SHOT claimed foul against the winner for alleged interference near the three-sixteenths pole but the Stewards found no reason to alter the original order of finish.
