SLAM DOWN forced the pace three and four wide, gained the lead near the sixteenth pole then was all out to last. MINING SHAFT advanced along the rail, was boxed in nearing the sixteenth pole, altered out but missed in a strong effort. SEA DUBAI stumbled at the start, rushed to the lead, led until nearing the sixteenth pole. OURREN stalked the leaders four wide, lacked a late response. FOR APPEAL found his best stride late, four wide. LEXCOAL six wide along the backstretch, was no factor. BIG CASE pressed the pace just off the rail, fell back around the turn. JET PROSPECTOR prompted the issue three wide, tired then was vanned off after the finish. TYM BEAU showed little inside. RUSH TO FRONT had little left after a half, four wide.
