Footnotes

IN THE BUBBLES dueled on a slim lead from the rail, drew off around the turn then was all out to last. TOUGH TALKING sluggish at the start, moved up three and four wide, closed with a rush through the lane. LONG SHADOW forced the pace three wide, lacked a closing bid. RUTLEDGE LION prompted the issue three wide, lacked a late response. RED LIGHT pressed the pace just off the rail, lacked the needed rally. HEARTBREAK AFFAIR six wide along the backstretch, dropped to the rail on the turn, never threatened. HESITANT GROOM stalked the leaders from the rail, failed to respond. ZION'S TREASURE made little impact, four and five wide.
