**Footnotes**

LOOSE N CAPABLE stalked the pace off the rail, bid nearing the five sixteenths pole, took aim in the three path of the final turn, lost some ground entering the stretch but dug in from there to take over in late yards. INNER POWER rated a short lead inside, was pressured past the three eighths pole, contested the edge through the final turn but was caught in late yards. PANTASTIC, shut off four wide into the first turn, moved to contention three wide leaving the seven sixteenths pole, gave chase from that point and kept aim to deep stretch before leveling off. BORN TO CUS settled back off the rail, bid leaving the three eighths pole and was gaining slowly in late stretch. RUTLEDGE LION kept close to the early pace toward mid track but lacked further response rounding the final turn. PROUD PLUCK, well back inside, made a mild bid near the rail on the final turn. PUNK ROBINSON, well back of the early pace off the rail, moved to the outside leaving the first turn, was never a factor then bumped outward nearing the head of the lane. MIGHTY FENIAN, five wide the opening turn, settled back off the rail, was never a factor then bumped out leaving the final turn. COOPER COUNTY settled close to the early leaders inside, started a bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole, steadied while in tight quarters approaching the quarter, resumed his bid through the final turn but broke down approaching the head of the lane.
