Footnotes

D K'S WILDCAT settled off the duel while racing off the rail and in the clear, advanced two wide around the far turn, angled to the rail to squeeze through a narrow opening turning for home, closed inside, was bumped in deep stretch and was up in time. DO IT WELL pressed the pace two wide between rivals, took command entering the far turn, edged clear nearing the lane, drifted in leaving the sixteenth pole, bumped the winner late and held second. UNCLE BOB'S VIPER disputed the pace four wide throughout, weakened and held clear for the show. TWO STEP B vied three wide between rivals and gave way near the three-sixteenths pole. JOHAR'S BIG CHARM was unhurried while racing three wide early and improved his position four wide around the far turn. STONE DANCER saved ground and failed to menace. GREEN PASTURES set a heavily pressured pace along the inside and tired entering the far turn. RAQUETTE RIDER was outrun inside. WILLEECADOO broke outwardly and bumped SMART SAINT just after the start, raced four wide around the first turn and was never a factor. SMART SAINT broke awkwardly, was bumped hard just after the start then made little impact while racing four and five wide.
