PROUD OF MIDWAY disputed the pace along the rail, took the lead nearing the five-sixteenths marker, dueled inside of EDDIE C. around the far turn, edged away from that rival while drifting out under left-handed urging in upper stretch, continued to drift under a vigorous hand ride in deep stretch and just lasted in a game effort. NO BRAKES was unhurried along the rail around the first turn, continued to lack speed in the three path around the clubhouse turn, began a mild advance while racing two wide around the far turn, angled to the rail nearing the sixteenth pole, closed inside of the winner and just missed. OILTON settled off the pace in the two path, made a slight gain while racing three wide around the far turn and rallied on the far outside in the stretch. EDDIE C. pressed the pace three wide and weakened in the lane. WILD AND WILEY failed to menace while racing two wide. DAY FLIGHT lacked speed along the rail, swung five wide nearing the far turn and had no rally. GOLD SCORE set a pressured pace between rivals and tired nearing the far turn.
