PAT'S ROSE stalked the early pace from the inside, advanced up the backstretch, altered outside entering the second turn, gained command and was well clear late while under steady urging. DECORATED WELL broke in at the start bothering CNETERPOINT BABY, was unhurried, advanced outside up the backstretch, responded but could only gain the place. UNBRIDLED CHARM dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, held a forward position at the eighth pole but could not keep pace. CYNTHIA'S ANGLE checked entering the first turn when in tight, chased the early pace from the inside, made a bid entering the stretch and finished well. SOLO MISSION went evenly. ICY LOVER dueled from the inside early, remained engaged up the backstretch but tired in the drive. DANCING TURK was bothered at the start, chased the early pace and tired.
