Footnotes

MISTER BRASS raced off the pace inside, made a three wide run on the far turn, dueled with UNLIMITED BUD in upper stretch and prevailed under a drive. UNLIMITED BUD stalked inside, moved up three wide to contest the pace on the backside, gained a short lead and dug in gamely inside through the stretch. FRED HIGH was outrun early, moved up outside on the turn, came six wide into the lane and closed belatedly outside. WAVES AND TIDES tracked inside, raced on the rail around the far turn and failed to sustain a bid. DOC'S DANCER raced off the pace, saved ground on the far turn and had no rally. LUCA'S WIND DANCER broke through the gate prior, raced off the pace and passed tired foes. NICK'S MONSTER was bumped at the start, raced three wide on the turn, then five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. ROBB'S WARRIOR dueled inside and tired. BIG SHOTOFTEQUILA broke through the gate prior, chased and faded. CAMDENS FAVORITE was bumped at the start, dueled outside and gave way.
