CRUSADER'S ANGEL broke sharp from the outside to quickly gain the early margin, remained well clear up the backstretch, widen the effort entering the second turn, held a commanding advantage at the eighth pole and proved much the best while never asked. SNUCK IN FOR FREE stalked the early pace from the inside, altered outside entering the second turn, responded and was just up for the place. PHONE JAZZ chased the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the second turn but could not keep pace. WEEKENDONTHEMOON well placed from the inside, remained forward through the second turn but had nothing left for the drive. HOLLY GO LIVELY could only improve position. PRIZED AFFAIR could only pass tired ones. NO SHOPPING MARIA chased the early pace from the outside and tired. MEMORIAL DRIVE had a steady fade. QUEEN OF ALL CATS was finished early.
