Footnotes

SERGEANT SAXTON set the pace in the two path, turned back a bid from BODIDDLE nearing the lane, continued on his left lead lead and drew off under a drive. ISLAND SKY stalked the pace four wide around the first turn, remained close up while racing three wide around the far turn, could not match strides with the winner in upper stretch and won the duel for the place. BODIDDLE prompted the pace three wide, bid nearing the lane but weakened in the lane. RUTLEDGE STAR was brushed just after the start, settled off the pace in the three path, advanced four wide around the far turn and flattened out in the lane. REFLECTED AFFAIR stalked the pace from the rail and came up empty. KING BLING was brushed just after the start, tracked the pace two wide and faded. R. B. FLOAT saved ground early, raced four wide around the far turn and was outrun. MAXIMUM SECURITY never factored while racing four wide.
