RUSTENBURG gave early chase toward mid track, saved some ground on the turn then dueled for place. UNUSUAL LAZ gave chase about the three path and was along for show. MACHO CAMACHO chased the pace off the rail, gave up place in late yards and leveled off toward the wire. SUMMERTON chased the leaders while off the rail to the top of the lane before flattening out. NAVY SEAL lost contact early.
