Footnotes

ED GRAY SPORTS broke well from the inside to duel for the early lead, dueled up the backstretch with WARRIORINTHESKY, put that one away entering the third turn, opened a clear advantage entering the drive and held sway the final furlong. ALL IRISH unhurried early while outside rivals, steadily advanced up the backstretch, reached a forward position entering the third turn, responded when sat down for the drive but could not reach the winner. TIJUANA RUN chased the early pace from the outside, remained forward entering the third turn but had nothing left for the drive. STILL KISSIN outrun early, advanced outside entering the third turn, responded and finished well while no threat late. WARRIORINTHESKY dueled from the outside, remained forward entering the third turn but had nothing left. DEMIDOFF EXPRESS chased the pace from the inside but had no late response. SPELL ME chased the early pace outside and tired. RUNAWAY CHRIS up close early while between foes, tired in the drive. HE'S GOT THE FEVER was never close. EZ MAC had a steady fade.
