BIGUM broke sharp from the inside, dueled for the early lead, gained a clear margin up the backstretch, widen the effort entering the drive and was clear late while kept to task. TACTICAL ASSAULT unhurried early, steadily advanced up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the third turn, responded when sat down for the drive but could not reach the winner. CALM AND COLLECTED stalked the early going from between foes, crept close entering the third turn but could not keep pace. NEVER MINED allowed to settle early, advanced up the backstretch, responded entering the drive but could not sustain. ANOTHER VOW chased the early pace from the inside but tired in the drive. KEY OF SOLOMON (IRE) could only improve position. WHAT TIME pressed the early pace from the inside and tired. ACROSS THE WIND was no factor. AMAZIN SUN was finished after going a half.
