SWEET TEA PLEASE stalked the early pace from the outside, steadily advanced up the backstretch, responded entering the drive, dueled through the stretch but was outfinished. MUM'S ZIP up close early from the outside, made a bid entering the second turn, dueled through the drive but was outfinished. DOMINIX up close early from the inside, dueled through the second turn but tired in the drive. NO IRONING SUNDAY up close early from between foes, dueled through the second turn but tired late. CASH VALUE was no factor. APPEALING SISTER could only pass tired ones. WHY DOC WHY was no threat. GRAY STORM A'COMIN had a steady fade. WELL BABE set the early pace and gave way.
