KING OF BOP rated close two deep, challenged for control from the three eighths pole, dueled to the front midstretch and dug in determinedly to discourage Bubba Bear. BUBBA BEAR settled just off the pace about the three path, bid nearing the five sixteenths pole, dueled to the girth of the winner in midstretch but was outfinished to the wire. BOMBER rated a short lead inside, was prompted for run past the five sixteenths pole, contested a slim advantage near the rail rounding the final turn, reluctantly ceded the edge in the upper stretch and leveled off in later yards. REACH FOR THE GOLD settled back inside, bid leaving the half mile pole, improved at the rail rounding the final turn, eased out midstretch and just missed taking third from the tiring pacesetter. FRED HIGH, well back outside, gave chase leaving the first turn, rounded the final turn about the four path and leveled off down the lane. EBONY raced well back inside. VIRGINIA AFFAIR kept close to the early pace toward mid track and lacked a response through the final turn. SIR PRIZE and SIR RAYFORD were not factors.
