Footnotes

ROGER'S STAR bumped with CROWN COURT just after the start, set the pace in the two path and drew off under a drive. IN MY CROSSHAIRS stalked the pace three wide and was clearly second best. SWAGGABOY prompted the pace from the rail, could not keep pace leaving the three-eighths pole but lasted for the show. CROWN COURT bumped with the winner just after the start, raced three wide around the first turn, saved ground thereafter and was never a threat. TOUCHDOWNTONY lacked speed while racing two and three wide, went five wide around the far turn and improved his position. TIE AND TAILS was outrun inside. CHANNELOFDREAMS had brief speed two wide. PROFETA was outrun while racing three wide.
