Footnotes

DISCO INDY sped to the early lead, opened up on the far turn, raced off the rail in the stretch and lasted under pressure. ALLEGHENY JACK lacked speed, saved ground on the turns, swung to the three path entering the stretch and closed the gap late. COOPER COUNTY saved ground, was forwardly placed and finished willingly. COCO POINT prompted the pace two wide and weakened the far turn. HOOLIHAN, wide entering the stretch, passed tired horses. ROMAN'S TOUCH, three wide between horses entering the stretch, lugged in approaching the sixteenth pole and was not a factor. OLYMPIC PEGASUS was outrun. ACADEMY RUN, a forward factor early, faltered the far turn.
