PERFECT CREVASSE was a bit rank at the start, settled in the two path around the first turn, advanced down the backstretch, took the lead three wide leaving the quarter pole, vied outside around the far turn then drew off under a drive in the lane. PURE SERENITY stalked the pace from the rail, lugged out under left-handed urging in upper stretch, straightened out and closed under a vigorous hand ride to gain the place in the final strides. LIONOFWALLSTREET set a pressured pace along the rail and weakened in the lane. CAME EAST chased the pace two wide and lacked the needed rally. GENTLEMAN JOHN stalked the pace three wide and came up empty. MOOKIE'S BROTHER failed to menace while racing three and four wide. STORM IN YOUR EYES pressed the pace two wide and tired around the far turn. ISLAND SKY played no factor while racing four wide. LOUD RAVENS was outrun well off the rail. PERSONAL EDGE saved ground early and retreated three wide around the far turn.
