Footnotes

TACTICAL TERRA broke out making light contact with Credit Risk, bounced back to exchange contact with Baby Harlow, rated close toward mid track, started a three wide bid leaving the three eighths pole, drew alongside four wide in mid turn then dug in for the lead midstretch and held Val's Heart at bay from there. VAL'S HEART, well back of the early pace off the rail, moved to the outside with a bid from the half mile pole, rounded the final turn about the four path, swung five wide into the stretch and finished well. SHORT BUT SWEET moved to a slim lead while angling inward toward the three quarter pole, rated the pace off the rail leaving the first turn, was pressured for more at the five sixteenths pole and kept the edge through the upper stretch before weakening. SHE'S HOT STUFF rated close off the rail, gave chase leaving the three eighths pole, was hemmed in from mid turn, angled to the rail with a bid into the stretch and just missed show. BABY HARLOW broke out brushing the gate and made contact with Tactical Terra, stalked the pace three wide, challenged from the five sixteenths pole, dueled to a slim brief lead mid turn but dropped back between horses nearing the head of the lane and weakened toward the sixteenth pole. CRIMSON PAGE, off the pace inside, angled out with a bid past the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn six wide and had little left in the stretch. WILD FLARE raced well back saving ground. RIVER WALTZ kept close inside the opening turn then faded through the backstretch.

CREDIT RISK, bumped lightly at the start, kept close to the early pace outside but gave way from the five sixteenths pole. HAPPY SPIRIT was shuffled back early and not a factor.
