THEWAYOFTHE SAMURAI advanced along the rail, angled out three wide for the drive then was up in the final strides. REBEL CHALLENGER forced the issue three and four wide, gained a slim lead at the top of the stretch and led until the final strides. PULVERIZER set the pace on rail, drew off down the backstretch, weakened the last sixteenth. ONE SMART GOLFER bore out and steadied at the start, moved up on the rail and finished well. MALA MALA CAT pressed the issue just off the rail, swung out four wide on the turn, lacked a late response. PAPER ROUTE made little impact, four and five wide. ROYAL SONATA flashed early speed three wide, steadily fell back. PAVAN PUTTAR was no factor along the inside. JUDGE MARSHALL had little left after a half, three wide.
