Footnotes

DIRTEATER four wide down the backstretch, moved up along the rail around the turn, was set down for the drive and up in the final strides. TEA TOT pressed the issue from the inside, gained a clear lead along the backstretch, led until the final strides. LEAR OF THE CAT three and four wide, closed with a rush. COPPER RIVER stalked the leaders three wide, angled to the rail on the turn and finished well. BOLD ATTEMPT with the leaders three wide, lacked a closing bid. HEEZAREALHEPKAT set the pace on the rail, gave way around the turn. SADDLER'S BOY was no factor, three wide. CAROLINA BARON off a step slow, failed to menace five and six wide. INTO THE NIGHT was used up after a half on the rail. SIOUXPERDUDE flashed brief foot from the inside.
