COLONEL RUTLEDGE unhurried early, advanced outside entering the second turn, responded when asked to gain the advantage mid stretch and was clear late under steady urging. TIN PAN ALLEY CAT well placed from the inside, crept closer entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive but could not reach the winner. LEOBUSTER stalked the early pace from the inside, dropped back up the backstretch, responded when asked, reached a striking position entering the drive, was blocked mid stretch when behind tiring rivals, got through inside and finished gamely. BAY BUTTON BILL pressed the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the second turn, drifted upper stretch and finished evenly late. TAYLOR'S FLIGHT dueled from the outside early, remained engaged up the backstretch, held a forward position entering the drive but tired. BRAVE TIGER was no factor. SONOFAWILDCAT dueled from the inside for the early lead, battled up the backstretch but tired in the drive. IJADA'S RUN pressed the early pace outside and gave way.
